

This is something my family started in 2020: The Year of Improvising—and will continue to build on, mess with, and collect from every year. Most of it will be familiar to you if you've observed Advent before and some of it will be new. I encourage you to use this however it is helpful to you and make it your own!

### HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE:

Whatever seems fitting for your family. I use the videos as a way to call our attention and funnel us to each other.

Prayer: Each prayer begins by naming some part of God. We are pulling out particulars from the Universal Source and asking for God's help in staying present with that focus.

Candle: You can use any candles you have (you will need five total), but traditionally, you will have 3 purple, 1 rose, and 1 white. As you light the candle, read out loud the text for that candle and contemplate the places where the light overcomes darkness and illuminates God's Dream in the Christmas Story.

Scripture: Read from your preferred version.

Officity: If you have a Nativity Set, you will place it out piece by piece as you approach Christmas. Each week we sing O Come, O Come, Emmanuel as we place the pieces for that week. Feel free to look up other verses to sing in addition or instead of. Or choose another song entirely that speaks to you and your family of the hope, faithfulness, joy, peace and love we bring into focus this season!

### 1ST SUNDAY (or Monday or Wednesday or Friday, as the case may be) -

//ideo: Bible Project Advent Study Hope

Prayer: God who promises, help us to be present to your presence here. Help us to not exclude one moment from the infinite possibility you provide. Help us to consider all of it as part of the thing you are holding and healing in your capable hands.

18 (and purple): The light of the prophets cracks the dark with hope for God's Dream to come true.

Scripture: Isaiah 40:3-5, Isaiah 7:14, Isaiah 9:2

## 2ND SUNDAY - Faithfulnegs

() Leo: Bible Project Word Study Emet - Faithful

Prayer: God who stays, help us to be present to your presence here. Help us to trust your loving guidance in our reflection and to remember together the ways you have always been with us. Help us to see your love in places we may not have been able to before.

2nd Candle (purple): The light of Bethlehem cracks the dark with faithfulness to God's trustworthy Dream.

Prayer: God who celebrates, help us to be present to your presence here. Help us to acknowledge where we feel afraid and receive your kindness there. Remind us we are free to rejoice however it looks right now in love that holds dark and light together.

3rd Candle (rose): The light of the **shepherds** crack the dark with joy in God's good and beautiful Dream.

## 4TH SUNDAY - Peace

Prayer: God who comforts, help us to be present to your presence here. Help us to find names for the rubble we stumble over and trust in your restoration. Show us where the rest is under all of the unrest. Remind us of what is whole when all we see are pieces. Give us your peace, which is active and full.

The light of the **angels** cracks the dark with peace over God's restful Dream.
